

# CAMPSITE RESERVATIONS AND RULES

May 2009

Reservations are required to utilize the campground.

The fee per night is \$20.00, payable at time of reservation by credit card. Reservations must be made by Holley by the Sea members 18 years of age and older. Members must verify ownership at time of reservation. The maximum usage for campground sites by each member is 30 days per year. Individual camper/s are limited to 30 days per year. Reservation is for campsite area. Guests wanting to use the rest of the facility must come to the front office and be signed in by the HBTS member or sign in with a guest pass card.

Members must stop by Customer Service on date of arrival to complete all paperwork and to pick up campground information sheet, pass and gate remote. Check in for campsite must be completed by 8:00pm on the date of arrival. No after hours check-in is available. Members will be charged starting from the date the pass and gate remote is issued. Remote requires a deposit of \$35.00.

Check-in time is 2:00pm daily excluding holidays.

Checkout time is 1:00pm daily excluding holidays.

Anyone desiring to checkout on a holiday when the facility is closed will be charged for an additional day's stay.

Please check with customer service upon check-in to confirm.

Cancellation notice is required no later than 7 days prior to arrival date.

All refunds are subject to a \$20.00 cancellation fee. Refunds will be mailed to the member within 30 days of request to the member's mailing address on file with customer service.

Members may extend their stay at the campground up to the 30-day maximum period. Any stay beyond the 30-day limit will result in a charge to the members' credit card or to their membership account at the rate of \$40.00 per day. Power will be shut off to the campsite five days after the reservation expires unless a hardship exists and customer service is promptly notified. The \$40.00 per day rate will continue during this time and will be charged to either the credit card or to the members' account. Failure to vacate the campground in a timely manner under normal conditions will result in suspension of Recreation Center privileges and park usage, plus associated costs incurred with having RV towed from property.

Switching of campsites is not authorized without prior approval. Unauthorized switching may result in cancellation of campsite usage and a \$40.00 charge.

Campsites must be kept clean at all times. Members who fail to clean up before leaving will be charged a \$40.00 cleaning fee.

Open fires and clotheslines are not permitted

Pets are allowed on the campsite only and must be kept on a leash at all times while outside. No pets are allowed anywhere else on the property or the beach.

Parking is permitted at individual campsites. Additional parking is available in the community parking lot only. No campers are allowed to park at other campsites or by the pavilions.

Music and noise is not permitted after 10:00pm in accordance with Santa Rosa County Ordinances.

No camping is permitted at the pavilions

There is a dump/lift station located near campsite #3. (Please refer to map provided)

Campers are responsible for their own security.

### NOTE FOR LARGE RV CAMPERS

Our current electrical load at the campsite is 50 amps. Large RV's may have to reduce power consumption to avoid electrical outages caused by overload.

Current height limits are 11 feet. This will aid in maneuvering around campground roads and also avoid scraping tree limbs. Campers with vehicles longer than 25 feet should conduct a safety check of area prior to arrival due to turn radius and close proximity to trees.

The campsite road is a one-way loop. Please stay on the red clay surface and do not drive into the inner circle of the loop due to the soft sand. Holley by the Sea is not responsible for vehicles stuck at the campground. Any towing and repair requirements will be the responsibility of the owner.
